In April 2017 the new **SPA of Portopiccolo** was inaugurated enriching the luxury offer of this elegant Karst stone village a few kilometers from Trieste.

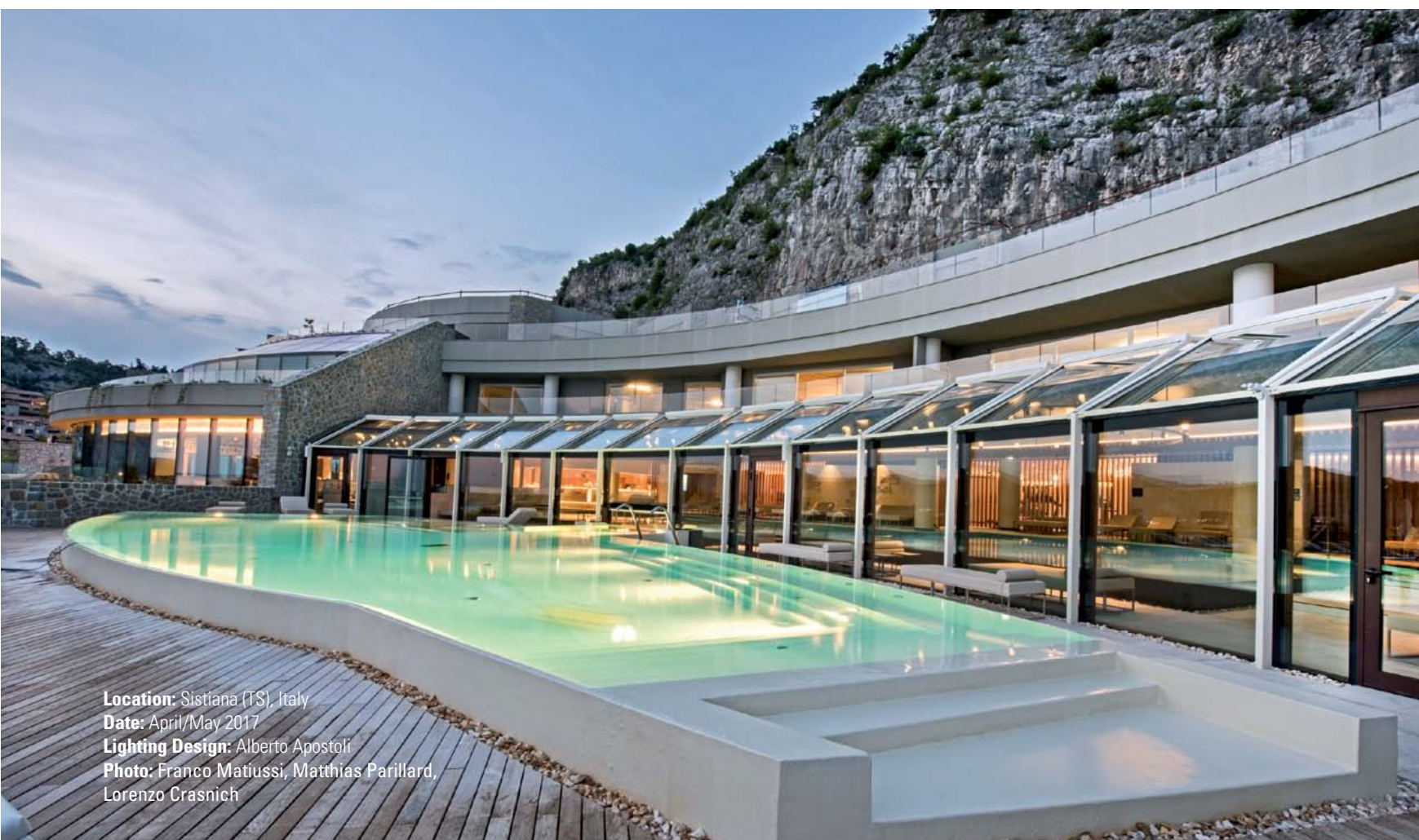
The concept concerns three levels, plus a basement dedicated to parking and service areas, for a total surface of 3,600 sqm.

The project idea wanted to support the *genius loci* of the cliffs overlooking the sea, alternating the stone with natural colors and the transparency of the glass.

This solution allows to lighten the structure, merging it with the surrounding gulf context and opening to its guests breathtaking views. The focus on wellness permeates the entire structure, starting from a more collective dimension, on the ground floor, and closing itself more and more to intimacy as the floors rise.
